Illinois Articulation Initiative General Education Core Curriculum Requirements:

Communication: Two-course sequence in writing (6 semester hrs, C grade required) and one course in oral communication (3 semester hrs).

Mathematics: One or two courses (3 to 6 semester hrs).

Physical and Life Sciences: Two courses (7 to 8 semester hrs). Select one course from Physical Science, and select one course from Life Science.

OR, select 2 interdisciplinary sciences courses (LP900 or LP900L and LP901 or LP901L). Select at least one laboratory course.

Humanities and Fine Arts: Three courses (9 semester hrs). Select one course from Humanities, one course from Fine Arts and one course from either Humanities or Fine Arts.

Social and Behavioral Sciences: Three courses (9 semester hrs). Select 3 courses from at least two different disciplines.

These courses are lower division foundation course requirements for all CBM undergraduate students – 21 hours

CBM College – required courses for all CBM undergraduate students – 18 hours for accountancy students

ACC Major course work – 24 hours

Upper div electives required by major. Minimum of 12 hrs—these courses can be selected to earn a minor and can be outside the major (advisor approval)
