**Communication:** Two-course sequence in writing (6 semester hrs, C grade required) and one course in oral communication (3 semester hrs).

**Mathematics:** One or two courses (3 to 6 semester hrs).

**Physical and Life Sciences:** Two courses (7 to 8 semester hrs). Select one course from Physical Science. Select one course from Life Science.

**OR,** select 2 interdisciplinary sciences courses (LP900 or LP900L and LP901 or LP901L). Select at least one laboratory course.

**Humanities and Fine Arts:** Three courses (9 semester hrs). Select one course from Humanities, one course from Fine Arts and one course from either Humanities or Fine Arts.

**Social and Behavioral Sciences:** Three courses (9 semester hrs). Select 3 courses from at least two different disciplines.
