Hours: Hours are flexible and will depend on current events and outreach opportunities. Interns will be responsible for identifying, coordinating, and traveling to various events, as well as far reaching outreach targets and goals.

Primary Responsibilities:

Outreach team members will play an important role in building public support for the Reproductive Health and Access Act. This bill would protect the right of an individual to make personal decisions about whether or not to have a child.

The Reproductive Health and Access Act will:

- Put women's health first by protecting the rights created by Roe v. Wade
- Ensure that the government can't interfere with an individual's right to use or refuse contraception
- Increase access to reproductive education and health services throughout Illinois.

Outreach team members will recruit Springfield and Chicago west suburban area residents to support the Reproductive Health and Access Act through a petition drive. Interns will also identify and engage supporters to an email list, and may circulate petitions and educational materials to the public. Team members are not soliciting donations.
