Juvenile Delinquency File, 1934-76

The Illinois Department of Corrections, a department of state government, was established Jan. 1, 1970. The Juvenile Division of the department assumed responsibility for juvenile offenders from the Illinois youth commission. Activities and programs organized by the juvenile division include: The annual Governor's Conference on Youth, Publications on Substance Abuse, Child Abuse and Delinquency Prevention, the Illinois Junior Sports Jamboree, surveys on the detention of juveniles in county jails and the Chicago Area Project.

The juvenile delinquency file is divided into three series. Series I includes material on the Annual Governor's Conference on Youth (1961-72), The Chicago Area Project (1943-76), and the Illinois Junior Sports Jamboree; Publications; juvenile court acts; and literature on delinquency from Illinois and other states. Series II includes 32 Audio Tapes of the Annual Governor's Conferences (1965-71). Series III contains 16 reels of motion picture film about juvenile delinquency and activities organized by the juvenile division.

The file was donated to the archives by John Lovelock in 1976, and processed in Nov., 1987.
