Papers of Dr. G. Ernst Giesecke, Professor of Humanities and Acting Vice President for Academic Affairs (1970-71), Professor of Higher Education and Director of Educational Relations (1971-76), Professor Emeritus of Higher Education, Consultant in post-secondary education, and Planning Consultant for an alternative system of higher education since 1976 at Sangamon State University. Prior to these positions, he served as instructor and administrator at the University of Illinois (1937-49), North Dakota State University (1949-53), Texas Technological College (1953-59), the University of Chicago (1959-65), and the University of Toledo (1965-70).

The records were donated at four different times and are divided into four series. Series I (Box 1-8) includes publications, speeches, legal notes and material on campus unrest donated in 1977. Series II (Box 9-11), donated in 1983, includes material on the Alternative System of Higher Education, Community College Liaison, Florida System, Community College Frontiers, General University Matters, Oral History, Reform of the University, and the Illinois Community College Conference. Series III (Box 12-13), donated in 1976, includes course material, material on speakers, the Division of Vocational and Technical Education, Board of Higher Education, Community College Liaison, and Articulation Projects. Series IV (Box 14-16), donated in 1976, includes material on Junior Colleges in Illinois, and the Illinois Community College Board.
