UNIVERSITY BILL 15-10

**AMENDMENT REGARDING GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS
AT THE UNDERGRADUATE LEVEL:
SSU Catalog 1986-87, p. 22**

Must have successfully completed the following general education courses:

Humanities (two courses)	At least 6 semester hours
Social Science (two courses)	At least 6 semester hours
Math (one course)	At least 3 semester hours
Science, with lab (one course)	At least 4 semester hours
English (two courses, one of which is in composition)	At least 6 semester hours

The English composition course requirement must be met at another institution prior to admission to Sangamon State University.

If a student is admissible to the University, but has not fulfilled all of the lower division general education requirements listed above, that coursework (with the exception of the English composition course) may be completed at Sangamon State University. A maximum of twelve semester hours of general education requirements as listed above may, with program approval, be counted toward the sixty hours of upper division credits at Sangamon State University.

This amendment should be inserted below General Requirements:
Bachelor's Degrees. It effectively changes the general education requirements from an entrance requirement to a graduation requirement.
