

## Capital Scholars Honors Program Advising Guide for English Majors

CAP students planning to major in English (ENG) will need to complete the following requirements:

Foreign Language	(0)4 to 16 Hrs.
English Major	36 Hrs.
General Education Requirements (Math, Oral Comm, Speakers Series, Humanities)	13 Hrs.
Electives	<u>16 Hrs.</u>

English 301 Introduction to the Discipline, English 311 Introduction to Literary Theory and Criticism, and English 489 Capstone are required of all undergraduate majors. Majors must take at least one course in British literature, one course in American literature, and one course ending in 50-89.

CAP Honors/ENG students planning to spend a semester abroad should normally plan to be abroad during their junior year. See your English advisor no later than the first semester of your second year to begin planning how to complete the requirements for your major in conjunction with your semester abroad.
