

Capital Scholars Honors Program Advising Guide for History Majors

CAP students planning to major in History (HIS) will need to complete the following requirements:

Capital Scholars course work	39 Hrs.
Foreign Language requirement	(0)4 to 16 Hrs.
Prerequisites for major (HIS 203, and HIS 201 OR HIS 202)	6 Hrs.
HIS Major	33 Hrs.
General Education Requirements (Math, Oral Comm, Speakers Series, Humanities)	13 Hrs.
Electives	<u>13 to 29 Hrs.</u>
Total	120 Hrs.

History majors must complete HIS 203 US History, and HIS 201 World History **or** HIS 202 European History before enrolling in 300-level or 400-level History courses.

CAP/HIS students planning to spend a semester abroad should normally plan to be abroad during their junior year. See your history advisor no later than the first semester of your second year to begin planning how to complete the requirements for your major in conjunction with your semester abroad.
