

**Capital Scholars Honors Program
Advising Guide for Social Work Majors**

CAP students planning to major in Social Work (SWK) will need to complete the following requirements:

Capital Scholars course work	39 Hrs.
Foreign Language requirement	(0)4 to 16 Hrs.
SWK Major	44 Hrs.
General Education Requirements (Math, Oral Comm, Speakers Series, Humanities)	13 Hrs.
Electives	<u>12 Hrs.</u>

CAP Honors/Social Work students planning to spend a semester abroad should normally plan to be abroad during their junior year. See your history advisor no later than the first semester of your second year to begin planning how to complete the requirements for your major in conjunction with your semester abroad.

Social Work has four prerequisites, introductory courses in psychology, math/statistics, political science, and sociology. Appropriate psychology and math/statistics courses are built into the course schedule below. The sociology and political science prerequisites can be met via careful selection CAP Honors course sections. Students should consult their CAP advisor about appropriate sections.
