**Illinois Articulation Initiative General Education Core Curriculum Requirements:**

**Communication:** Two-course sequence in writing (6 semester hrs, C grade required) and one course in oral communication (3 semester hrs).

**Mathematics:** One or two courses (3 to 6 semester hrs).

**Physical and Life Sciences:** Two courses (7 to 8 semester hrs). Select one course from Physical Science. Select one course from Life Science **OR**, select 2 interdisciplinary sciences courses (LP900 or LP900L and LP901 or LP901L). Select at least one laboratory course.

**Humanities and Fine Arts:** Three courses (9 semester hrs). Select one course from Humanities, one course from Fine Arts and one course from either Humanities or Fine Arts.

**Social and Behavioral Sciences:** Three courses (9 semester hrs). Select 3 courses from at least two different disciplines.

These courses are lower division foundation course requirements for all CBM undergraduate students – 25 hours

CBM College Core – required courses for all CBM undergraduate students – 18 hours

BBA Major course work – 16 hours

Upper div electives req'd by major. Min 13 hrs. These can be selected to earn a minor and can be outside the major (advisor approval)
