**CLS TENURE-TRACK POSITION**

**POSITION DESCRIPTION:** The Department of Clinical Laboratory Science at the University of Illinois at Springfield (UIS) invites applications for a tenure-track position at the assistant professor level. This is a full time, nine-month appointment with opportunity for summer teaching and/or research. The CLS Program at UIS is a 2+2 NAACLS-accredited program. The successful candidate must have certification as CLS (NCA), MT (ASCP), or equivalent and must have clinical experience in medical microbiology. A master's degree is required with preference given to candidates with an earned doctorate. Primary responsibilities include teaching medical bacteriology and medical mycology/parasitology/virology and developing and coordinating the CLS microbiology clinical rotations. The candidate is also expected to participate in teaching other CLS courses. Depending on the candidate's interest, the candidate may also teach courses outside the major. Experience in online teaching is desirable. Advising, recruitment, and involvement with professional organizations and issues are also expected. The first responsibility of a faculty member at UIS is to demonstrate excellence in teaching. In addition, the successful candidate is expected to participate in scholarship and service.
