In spring 2005, there were 10,375 total graded enrollments considered, of them, 2,332 were from online sections (22.48%) and 8,043 were from non online sections (77.52%). In fall 2005, there were 11,518 total graded enrollments considered, of them, 2,784 were from online sections (24.17%) and 8,734 were from non online sections (75.83%). In spring 2006, there were 10,672 total graded enrollments considered, of them, 3,038 were from online sections (28.47%) and 7,634 were from non online sections (71.53%). In fall 2006, there were 12,417 total graded enrollments considered, of them, 3,220 were from online sections (25.93%) and 9,197 were from non online sections (74.07%). In spring 2007, there were 11,916 total graded enrollments considered, of them, 3,557 were from online sections (29.85%) and 8,359 were from non online sections (70.15%).
