



## CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

1. Host agree to abide by all applicable state and university laws regarding the possession and consumption of alcohol including, but not limited to the following;
  - a. Only persons 21 years of age or older will be permitted to consume alcohol.
  - b. Alcohol will not be sold without a state license. No money may change hands at any time during an event at which alcohol is served. Any such transactions will be viewed as liquor sales.
2. Hosts agree that attendees will be personally invited and that there will be no public means of advertisement of the party. All invitations must be personal or by word of mouth with the approval of the hosts. *For safety reasons, the Housing Office will limit the number of persons permitted to attend an event hosted in student residences.*
3. Hosts agree to contact, at least 48 hours in advance, their neighbors that share a wall, breezeway, and floor with their apartment in the building where the party will take place. They are to insure to those residents that;
  - a. The residents will not be unduly disturbed.
  - b. The person identified as the “designate” will be available to address specific complaints.
  - c. Disapproval may be voiced through the Housing Office by calling 206-6190 prior to the start of the event to allow for adequate compromise efforts.
4. The Designated Host guarantees they will maintain sobriety throughout the course of the event.
5. Hosts ensure that all extraneous noise will be eliminated no later than the designated ending time and that any noise complaints will be dealt with in a cooperative and timely manner.
6. Hosts agree to remove any and all litter or debris from outside campus common areas resulting from the event by Noon the following day, unless otherwise directed by the Housing Staff. If clean up is still not satisfactory; a clean-up charge may be assessed to the hosts of the party.
7. Hosts will be held liable for any damages or inappropriate behaviors caused by unidentifiable persons attending this event.
8. Hosts agree to fully and promptly cooperate with the instructions of the Housing Staff and the UIS Police Department. Failure to cooperate with any requests or directives concerning the actual event could result in the pursuit of legal action.
9. Any violations of the “Special Conditions/Comments” or the CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL segment of the agreement will automatically render this agreement null and void. The event becomes an unapproved or unregistered party at that time.
