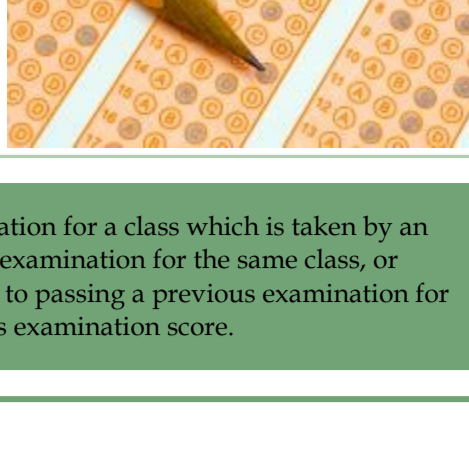
Question:

How many times can I take a civil service exam?

Answer:

Any applicant may rewrite a civil service examination for a class three times within any twelve month period, with at least one month time lapse between every rewrite.

The candidate's place on the register for the class shall be determined by the highest score achieved on any examination for the class.



"Rewrite Examination" is either an examination for a class which is taken by an applicant subsequent to failing a previous examination for the same class, or which is taken by an applicant subsequent to passing a previous examination for the same class in an attempt to improve his examination score.
