POSITION DESCRIPTION: ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN PSYCHOLOGY: The Psychology Department at the University of Illinois at Springfield has an opening beginning August 23, 2010, for a tenure-track position at the Assistant Professor level. Requirements include a Ph.D. from an accredited university, with a focus in Industrial & Organizational (I/O) Psychology or Judgment & Decision Making, to teach undergraduate upper and lower division courses in Introduction to Industrial & Organizational Psychology, Work Motivation, Personnel Psychology, Decision Making, Research Methods, and Principles of Psychology/Introduction to Psychology, with the possibility of teaching Social Psychology, Psychological Tests & Measurements, Statistics for the Behavioral Sciences, and courses in the candidate's specialty area. The applicant should demonstrate potential for scholarship and/or research in a specialty area. Normal teaching load is three 4 credit hour courses per semester. Advising is required. College teaching experience is preferred, and dedication to teaching is essential. A Ph.D. must be awarded by the start date.

QUALIFICATIONS: Ph.D. in Psychology with specialized training in Industrial and Organizational Psychology or a related area from a regionally accredited university by the start date. Prior evidence of excellence in teaching and a demonstrated potential for research is desirable. UIS is an affirmative action/equal opportunity employer.
