

The Plastic Bags and Containers Project has been ongoing since 2008. Every month a 30 gallon container is filled with plastic shopping bags, cottage cheese, yogurt, margarine, and other types of plastic containers by UIS students and staff. Located outside the Experiential and Service-Learning Programs office, this container is living proof of the generosity of the UIS community.

The containers are filled with leftover soup by St. John's Breadline and placed in a plastic bag for the clients. This re-purposing project was started by a Learning and Serving Hunger & Homelessness class.
