Resolution on the Creation of a Committee on Campus Safety

WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is vested with the authority to represent the students of the University of Illinois at Springfield (UIS) in issues affecting them; and

WHEREAS, campus safety has been a primary concern for students over the past several years and should be addressed by the SGA; and

WHEREAS, there is a recognized need for increased safety provisions such as improved lighting and strategically placed Code Blue emergency phones in many parts of campus; and

WHEREAS, there is also a need for more comprehensive sexual assault education for students as well as other preventative measures; and

WHEREAS, campus safety issues will only become more prevalent as the size of the campus increases and more incoming freshmen are accepted to UIS;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the UIS SGA charges a committee to examine campus safety issues and existing needs on campus, hold open forums to hear student safety concerns and meet with the UIS Police Department and administrators to discuss possible improvements.
