Resolution on Campus Safety

WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is vested with the authority to represent the students of the University of Illinois at Springfield (UIS) in issues affecting them; and

WHEREAS, campus safety has been a primary concern for students over the past several years and should be addressed by the SGA; and

WHEREAS, there is a recognized need for increased safety provisions such as improved lighting and strategically placed Code Blue emergency phones in many parts of campus; and

WHEREAS, campus safety issues will only become more prevalent as the size of the campus increases and more incoming freshmen are accepted to UIS; and

WHEREAS, the SGA's Committee on Campus Safety has conducted a safety walk that identified many problems, including inadequate lighting, overgrown vegetation and impractically placed Code Blues;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the UIS SGA asks administrators to review the findings of the Committee on Campus Safety and implement the attached recommendations.
