Improving the CPT program for MIS Graduate Students

WHEREAS, the University of Illinois Springfield (UIS) Student Government Association (SGA) is vested with the authority to be the voice for the student body; and,

WHEREAS, to be eligible for the CPT program, a student is expected to select a course they want to use for their CPT; and,

WHEREAS, in the MIS department there are a few/select courses that are available for the CPT program; and,

WHEREAS, by the time a student can get to their final semester they would have already taken those courses already. Thus at the final semester when they are ready for CPT program, the courses that they need for the program had already been taken rendering them ineligible for the CPT program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the department either increase the number of courses that students can use for the CPT program or make the system flexible in a way that students can be able to choose courses they would like to do CPT on in their third semester and do those courses at their final semester instead.
