To qualify for this scholarship, students must have completed the 2018-2019 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), available after October 1, 2017, selecting UIS as a college choice (Title IV code 009333). Undergraduate students must be enrolled in no fewer than six (6) required credit hours during any semester to be eligible for federal aid. The student must be enrolled in the appropriate Pre-Nursing Pathway courses and those courses must count toward the student's degree. The student must also be in compliance with the Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy. Additionally, the student must have completed the Institutional Scholarship application process with the UIS Office of Financial Assistance as well as this application.
