

5 WAYS YOU CAN...

Get your students creative with Multimedia

1 Send students out to get some hands-on experience prompting them to create a documentary. Using the **Flip Cams** available for checkout in the Media Lab, they are able to create their own films.

2 Prompt them to present a project that extends their creativity past the usual PowerPoint. There are endless choices-**Prezi**, **SlideRocket**, and more!

3 Incorporate creating a website as a project into your curriculum with **Google Sites**. It's a free and simple program and will allow them to incorporate videos, images, text, and more!



4 Put a twist on a paper assignment and have students create an "audio essay" following a presentation using **Camtasia Relay**!

5 Using the **video editing software** available in the Media Lab. Combine movie clips, audio, images, and more! Various programs are available including iMovie and a simpler alternative-Windows Movie Maker!
