

## UIS Math Placement Chart (February 17, 2020)

All students who request to register for MAT courses (all 100- and 09X- level) must satisfy the prerequisites for those courses. Prerequisites for all courses are listed on the UIS Catalog (under Course Description). For the following MAT courses, prerequisites are satisfied either by completing the prerequisite course(s) (as stated below) or by achieving appropriate scores on the math portion of standardized tests or math placement test (as stated below).

To retake a math placement test, students must wait 3 months before they can take the math placement test again.
