Applications for the 2009-2010 Children of Veterans Tuition Waiver are now available, according to the Fulton/Regional Office of Education.

The Children of Veterans Tuition Waiver is a four-year tuition waiver at the University of Illinois. It may be used at any of the university's campuses: Urbana-Champaign, Chicago, Health Sciences Center, Springfield or Global Campus.

Up to six scholarships are awarded per county -- one for each of the following wars/conflicts: World War II, Korean Conflict, Vietnam Conflict, Southwest Asia Conflict, Operation Enduring Freedom, and Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Specific information regarding the required service dates and medal eligibility is provided on the application itself.

Applications are being accepted for the tuition waiver between now and March 1, 2009. Applicants must be enrolled at or admitted to the University of Illinois by March 1, 2009.

Note that this tuition waiver is not for grandchildren of veterans.

For the online application, refer to the University of Illinois Web site at www.osfa.uiuc.edu. Click on "Forms" and the application is located in the scholarship category. Print out the application and mail it to the address on it.
