Student Government Association Resolution 2 (AY 2016-2017)

Formation of the Student Employment Task Force

WHEREAS, the University of Illinois Springfield (UIS) Student Government Association (SGA) is vested with the authority to be the voice for the student body; and,

WHEREAS, SGA as representatives of the student body establishes an interest in student employment as an economic necessity for the university; and,

WHEREAS, students apply and operate as university employees as a path towards financing their pursuit of an education during their time as a student; and,

WHEREAS, student employment provides work force experience that enhances skills and opportunities for desirable employment or career paths; and,

WHEREAS, the existence of flaws in the student employment system in the form of operations regarding student employment or university application processes may disadvantage students when pursuing or fulfilling student employment; and,

WHEREAS, SGA should investigate any complaints or structures that unfairly diminish student employment opportunities or confidence in their employment.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that SGA creates the new ad hoc committee, "Student Employment Task Force," in order to address flaws or concerns in the student employment system of the university.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the committee shall consist of five senators and two executive officers with the Chair and committee membership appointed by the Internal Vice-President.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Student Employment Task Force will investigate student complaints of unjust practices and legitimate issues in the student employment policies and operations of university employers.

THEREFRE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the committee shall investigate potential expansion of student employment upon the request of the SGA through legislative or executive action.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the committee shall introduce recommendations to SGA on possible actions to conduct upon the results of a committee investigation.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and recording by the Secretary of the Student Government Association.
