Amendment to Resolution Regarding Furlough Days

WHEREAS, The Student Government Association is vested with the authority to represent the students of The University of Illinois at Springfield (UIS) in issues affecting them; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois owes the University of Illinois over \$400 million dollars in money essential to the function of the University system; and

WHEREAS, Furlough days have been implemented for all university employees, making over \$30,000 per year, in order to reserve funds necessary to the function of the University; and

WHEREAS, Students and Faculty alike at UIS recognize that this is a terrible fiscal situation that affects the entire University; and

WHEREAS, Students and Faculty alike want to send a message to the State of Illinois and the Governor's Office that the mismanagement of State and UofI funds is not going unnoticed; and

WHEREAS, SGA recognizes that Students and Faculty alike want to minimize the impact of that furlough days that this fiscal situation has placed the University in;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that SGA supports all Faculty and Professors decisions' regarding furlough days. More importantly that the SGA, Students, and Faculty stand together in support of each other and organize formally to Lobby the Governor's Office directly with our concerns.
