Resolution 2009-002

Resolution to Amend the SGA Bi-Laws to Reform the ICCB

WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is vested with the authority to represent the students of the University of Illinois at Springfield (UIS) in issues affecting them; and

WHEREAS, the Inter-Club Council Board is a standing committee of the Student Government Association,

WHEREAS, the ICCB shall work to provide funding to any and all UIS student organizations and clubs. The money allocated to each club shall be used to improve student life at the University of Illinois at Springfield.

WHEREAS, All committees of the SGA shall be open to all members of the SGA and the public who wish to observe,

WHEREAS, student organizations are planning and scheduling events on a continual basis throughout the year,

WHEREAS, The ICCB board will determine an funding allocation limit per club at the beginning of the semester by looking at the following criteria: number of student organizations registered, ICCB budget for the year, and any relevant factors

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the ICCB report, to the SGA at the first SGA meeting following the election of the SGA Internal Vice President, the allocation limits determined by ICCB, in accordance with the ICCB bi-laws, at the beginning of the semester for student organizations.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that ICCB fully fund student organizations according to the established funding allocation limit as reported to the SGA at the beginning of each semester, if a student organization requests funds during the semester in accordance with ICCB's limitations for funding line item requests,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that ICCB hold bi-weekly meetings to consider student organization funding requests.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that ICCB may have executive session privileges pertaining to its votes and debate for funding requests under the condition that the outcome of each decision and vote be explained to the student organization representative at the same meeting and that the meeting minutes for the whole meeting, including executive session be made public and accurately transcribed to include all necessary information and that the roll call voting results of each funding vote be published in the minutes; clearly identifying the vote of each member.
