Resolution on Student Activity Fee Allocations for FY11

WHEREAS, The Student Government Association is vested with the authority to represent the students of The University of Illinois at Springfield (UIS) in issues affecting them; and

WHEREAS, students pay a Student Activity Fee that is used for programming above and beyond the institutional support services offered within the division of student affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Student Government Association's oversight of the use of the student fee is central to ensuring that resources are used to serve the student population at UIS; and

WHEREAS, the SGA believes it would be unwise to allocate funds based on enrollment figures that may or may not be met;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the SGA recommends that the incoming board for academic year 2010/11 allocate the reserved funds in the spring semester; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the attached comments from the Student Government Association be used to direct the offices receiving funds on the approved use of those funds.
