Constitutional Amendment to Establish a Committee on Programming

WHEREAS, The Student Government Association (SGA) has the responsibility to be present and recognized within the University community;

WHEREAS, SGA is vested with the power to make changes to the Constitution;

WHEREAS, SGA finds it necessary to establish a committee to further connect with the student body as a whole;

WHEREAS, this committee would organize events to promote SGA throughout the University,

WHEREAS, this committee would be devoted to enrich the UIS experience for students, faculty, and alumni,

THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED, that the SGA shall create a Committee on Programming that shall be posed to the student body for a vote to be voted on at the Fall 2011 Election. The amendment shall be the following:

ARTICLES VII: DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES

Section 2: The President shall appoint a Parliamentarian and an External Vice-President, to be approved by the SGA at-large within 2 business meetings of his/her tenure. The President shall appoint a Committee Chair for the Committee on Housing, the Committee on Food Services, and **the Committee on Programming**. The President shall be the Chair of the Committee on Student Fees.

ARTICLE XVII: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Constitution shall take effect on September 28, 2011.

“Shall the UIS Student Government Association Constitution be amended in accordance with SGA Resolution 2011-01, Constitutional Amendment to Establish a Committee on Programming?”
