**Student Government Association Resolution 14 of AY 2011-2012**

*Creation of Ad Hoc Committee on Undergraduate Advising*

WHEREAS, The Student Government Association is vested with the authority to represent student needs,

WHEREAS, academic advising is critical to a student's educational success and ability to graduate on time,

WHEREAS, the Campus Senate's Undergraduate Advising Task Force recently administered a survey that reflects student perceptions on academic advising,

WHEREAS, the survey suggested that a "student forum on advising at UIS" was needed to help address student concerns and,

WHEREAS, the SGA recognizes that multiple populations encompass the undergraduate community and value their input on this issue,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the SGA hereby creates an *Ad Hoc* Committee on Undergraduate Advising that will examine the issues concerning academic advising and that addresses student concerns,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Committee will work in conjunction with the Undergraduate Advising Task Force to forward advising policy changes that are to the benefit of students,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the chair of the Committee, who will be appointed by the SGA President, will choose the membership of the Committee, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the membership of the Committee will include, but is not limited to, one freshman or sophomore student who has not transferred from another institution, one junior or senior student currently enrolled in upper division classes in their major, one transfer student, and one student from each college.
