Student Government Association Resolution 1 (AY 2014-2015)

Supporting the Addition to Description of Duties for Senators in the SGA Bylaws

WHEREAS, the Senators of University of Illinois Springfield (UIS) Student Government Association (SGA) are responsible for investigating/expressing student concerns and opinions within their respective schools or interests.

WHEREAS, Student Activities Committee (SAC) and the Student Organization Funding Association (SOFA) received 58% of Student Activities Fee Allocations for the 2014-2015 academic year; the fee allocations are decided by SGA each year. SAC and SOFA are subsidiary committees of SGA.

WHEREAS, the Senators of SGA should be involved with SAC and SOFA.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Senators of SGA are required to attend a minimum of one SAC and one SOFA meeting per semester.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, This will be accomplished through the UIS Student Government Association adding to the bylaws a Clause D in Article II Section 8 with the following language:

Clause D. The Senators of the SGA will attend a minimum of one Student Activities Committee (SAC) and one Student Organization Funding Association (SOFA) meeting per semester.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that if passed by the UIS SGA, this bylaw will go into effect immediately.
