Student Government Association Resolution 6 (AY 2014-2015)

Supporting an Addition to Restrict Simultaneous Funding Requests from SGA and SOFA

WHEREAS, the University of Illinois Springfield (UIS) Student Government Association (SGA) is vested with the authority to allocate funds to campus organizations' events in addition to Student Organization Funding Association (SOFA);

WHEREAS, the funds allocated to SOFA come from the activity fee allocations funded by SGA;

WHEREAS, requesting from both SGA and SOFA for one event creates an overuse of allocated fees;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the bylaws have an addition to prevent the allocation of funds to one organization's event pending the same request has been given to SOFA;

THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Student Government Association make the following addition to the current bylaws under Article III, Section 3:

Clause D: Funds for student organizations may be requested from either the Student Government Association or the Student Organization Funding Association. However, the requesting of funds from both associations simultaneously is prohibited.
