<sup>2</sup>A minimum grade of C- is required in ALL foundation courses EXCEPT ACC 211 & ACC 212 where a minimum grade of a C (2.0) is required. A cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 is required across all college foundation courses.

<sup>3</sup>A minimum grade of B or better is required in ACCT 201 and ACCT 202 to meet requirements.

<sup>4</sup>A maximum of 66 hours of transfer credit from RCC may be applied towards this bachelor's degree program.

<sup>5</sup>Engagement Experience. A minimum of 3 hours of Internship course work (IPL 300) for Engagement Experience is required (6 hours Internship recommended). 10 Hours total ECCE required.

<sup>6</sup>At least 48 hours of upper division (300-400 level) coursework required. If you elect to complete ACCT 201 and/or ACCT 202 at UIS, you may replace those RCC credits with the equivalent number of RCC lower division electives.
