

# English Proficiency Requirements for the University of Illinois Springfield

Applicants whose native language is not English, including those within the U.S. as a permanent resident, must meet one of these 4 UIS English Proficiency Admission Requirements. If you meet one of the following requirements, you may petition to have your requirement waived via this form.

## 1. Complete a Qualifying Academic Program

**U.S. High School:** Official transcript showing graduation from accredited U.S. high school or U.S. Department of Defense School overseas-attended for at least 3 years

**U.S. Degree:** Official transcript of U.S. accredited Associate's, Bachelor's, Master's or Doctoral degree

### Degrees outside of the U.S. that qualify:

1) High School Diploma or 2) College/University Degree and Citizenship from one of the below English-speaking countries (not the United States). Official transcripts and degrees will require an evaluation to be completed by a company that is a member of the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES). ## 2. Achieve a Qualifying Score on an English Language Proficiency Test Accepted by UIS

Qualifying scores must have been obtained within the last 2 years, the only exception is for applicants that submit scores for a test taken more than 2 years ago is if the student has been continuously studying at a college or university within the U.S.

## 3. Complete Qualifying Courses, Degrees or Diplomas

### College Level English courses

Applicants who have successfully completed with a "B" or higher Composition 1 and 2 and a Speaking course at an accredited college or university in the U.S., or one of the above listed English-speaking countries.

### Earned College hours

Applicants who transfer with 60 credits and a GPA of 2.00 or better on a 4.00 scale from an accredited college or university in the U.S. or one of the above listed English-speaking countries.

Student must be enrolled at the time of application and must have maintained continuous enrollment prior to their transfer to UIS to meet this requirement.

## 4. Demonstrate Qualified Employment Experience

Applicants who have a minimum of two years of professional employment experience in the U.S. or one of the above listed English-speaking countries. This demonstration is subject to employer verification.
