This 1.6 conversion factor is NOT applied to hours that count as business, business ethics, or business communications within the template; strictly is for accounting hours only. For example, note that ACC563, Commercial Law is counted as 3 hours Business credit, including ½ credit of Business Communication. Weighting factor is not applicable in that example.
