Cost of Attendance

Federal law requires all colleges and universities to calculate an estimated average Cost of Attendance (COA/budget) for an academic year (Fall/Spring). The COA is not the actual price you will pay, but rather an estimate of what it might cost you to attend your classes, live, and have basic necessities while attending.

- The tuition, fee, and assessment amounts in these COAs apply to students who are NOT in an online program. Students who have applied and been
 admitted to an online program and take 100% online courses pay different tuition, fee, and assessments. Any student enrolling in an online course will
 also incur an Online Academic Support Fee of \$45/credit hour.
