- A signed copy of the 2021 IRS Form 1040X, "Amended U.S. Individual Income Tax Return," that was filed with the IRS

#### NON-IRS TAX RETURNS: (Individuals who filed a tax return in a foreign country, Puerto Rico, or U.S. Territory)

- Signed copy of the filed 2021 tax return
- Convert amounts earned to U.S. currency, providing the equivalent to each parent's income from work, Adjusted Gross Income, Income Taxes Paid

#### **IRS IDENTITY THEFT VICTIMS:**

- Tax Return Database View (TRDBV) transcript for 2021
- Signed and dated statement (by both parents) indicating the individuals were a victim of IRS taxrelated identity theft and the IRS is aware of the tax-related identity theft


