

## Estimated Cost of Attendance

Federal law requires all colleges and universities to calculate an estimated average Cost of Attendance (COA/budget) for an academic year (Fall/Spring).

The COA is not the actual price you will pay, but rather an estimate of what it might cost you to attend your classes, live, and have basic necessities while attending. **Total financial aid offered may not exceed the estimated Cost of Attendance.**
