### **Other Important Information**

- \* All students, except 100% online, are charged \$1124/semester (estimated) for health insurance. This may be waived.
- \*\* Students who reside off campus will not be charged on-campus housing & meal plans. Off-campus students will have rent, utilities, food, etc. that they should estimate.
- Federal Work Study You may be eligible for Federal Work Study, which is not aid paid to your account. Rather, it is earned as a paycheck for the hours worked if you work on campus.

#### **Definitions**

- Direct Costs: Tuition, Fees, and Housing & Food (if on campus).
- Indirect Costs: Represents an average estimate of other related expenses. You are in control of these expenses. Indirect Costs are not charged to your UIS account.
- Grants and Scholarships: Gift aid you do not have to repay.
- Self-Help Aid: Must be repaid. Federal student loans, parent PLUS loans, other education loans.
