Students wishing to be considered for the Spring 2026 Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship must be <u>newly admitted</u> to an <u>on-campus degree program</u> at UIS beginning Spring 2026. Students must apply <u>prior</u> to their first semester at UIS. Scholarship recipients may receive this scholarship for a total of up to 4 consecutive semesters (excluding summer terms).

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Submit the following items via mail or email to UIS Office of Admissions. All items must be received by the deadline posted below to be considered for this scholarship.

- Completed application form
- **Personal Essay** should identify specific characteristics such as personal, educational, and vocational goals, awards, honors, volunteer work, community involvement, and activities. The format of the narrative is at the discretion of the student.
- **2 Letters of Recommendation** may be from faculty, academic program committee members, an employer, or someone who knows you well.
- Official documentation indicating your induction into your community college's Phi Theta Kappa chapter.

**Renewal criteria:** enroll each semester on a full-time basis (at least 12 credit hours per semester) and maintain a minimum 3.0 institutional GPA.
