Articulation Pathway Partnership

The following documents are a proposal to students who wish to complete their AAS in MLT at Oakton College to then continue on to UIS for their BS in MLS. The articulation pathway can be completed online or on campus, whichever modality is best for the student. All coursework and structure has been approved by the departments at both Oakton College and University of Illinois Springfield.

The first two pages of the document following this cover sheet are a side by side of the whole curriculum broken out by semester. An AAS does not guarantee all general education requiremets are met for Bachelor's degree completion. The second page lists prerequisites for some courses at UIS that are not fulfilled at Oakton as well as those general education courses that are not fulfilled at Oakton. These courses are listed separately to allow flexibility for the student to take them however is best for them. Whether that is at Oakton College, via CLEP (College Level Examination Program), or at UIS. This will not hinder a student's time or ability to complete their AAS at Oakton College, but they are needed for BS completion at UIS.

The second two pages are a more detailed view of the program, still in the semester-by-semester structure. One page is coursework taken at Oakton College for the AAS and how those courses translate/transfer to UIS courses. The second page is coursework taken at UIS for the BS and the remaining courses needed for BS completion as mentioned prior. Again, these courses are not needed to complete the AAS at Oakton, but are needed for BS completion at UIS.
