Fall 2015 COPE Meeting

Elementary

Double Major

- FA 15 is the first opportunity for students to be admitted to the new Elementary Double major program.
- Students already admitted to the elementary minor must complete the "old" program by September 1, 2017
 - (SP 17 student teaching).

Middle Level

"Old" Middle School endorsements cannot be issued after January 31, 2018. New programs for Middle Level licensure are effective February 1, 2018.

Teacher Prep (ELEM, MS, SECE)

APT test

Not through JCAR, but ISBE advises that APT is not needed for anyone required to do edTPA.

After 8/31/15 PEL holders seeking new endorsements will be grandfathered in as the APT will not be offered unless the candidate completed student teaching before 8/31/15.

Administrative



- Candidates who completed the GADM program prior to September 1, 2014
 - who have a master's degree
 - 2 years of teaching/school support personnel experience
 - Pass a Basic Skills Exam and
 - Pass the Principal #186 test

May apply for the GADM endorsement during a window that is open until June 30, 2016.

Administrative Con't

SUPT

Beginning September 1, 2016 institutions may only admit new candidates to superintendent prep programs that have been approved under Part 33 of Illinois Administrative Code.
