

University of Illinois Springfield Student Government Association Resolution 021

Amending Article XI Section 3, 5, and 6 of the Bylaws

Resolution Sponsor: Parliamentarian Grant Gustafson

WHEREAS, the University of Illinois Springfield (UIS) Student Government Association (SGA) is vested with the authority to be the voice for the student body; and,

WHEREAS, it is the goal of SGA to utilize its time efficiently.

WHEREAS, The Parliamentarian shall, prior to passage of any amendment to the Bylaws, provide a written opinion to the Student Government Association detailing the effect that any proposed amendment would have on the Bylaws.

WHEREAS, No opinion letter from the Parliamentarian shall be unreasonably withheld.

WHEREAS, In the event that the Student Government Association makes a determination that such opinion letter is being unreasonably withheld by the Parliamentarian, the Student Government shall reserve the authority to approve the amendment to the Bylaws without an opinion letter from parliamentarian.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that SGA make the following amendments to Article XI of the Bylaws:

Section 3. The Parliamentarian shall, prior to passage of any amendment to the Bylaws, may provide a written opinion to the Student Government Association detailing the effect that any proposed amendment would have on the Bylaws.

Section 5. No opinion letter from the Parliamentarian shall be unreasonably withheld.

Section 6. In the event that the Student Government Association makes a determination that such opinion letter is being unreasonably withheld by the Parliamentarian, The Student Government shall reserve the authority to approve the amendment to the Bylaws without an opinion letter from parliamentarian.
