Student Government Association Resolution 037

Amendment to Article V Section 1 of the Constitution Resolution Sponsor: Parliamentarian Grant Gustafson

WHEREAS, the University of Illinois Springfield (UIS) Student Government Association (SGA) is vested with the authority to be the voice for the student body; and,

WHEREAS, It is imperative that SGA remain up-to-date with current enrollment criteria; and,

WHEREAS, Half-time status is defined as being enrolled for a minimum of six (6) credit hours as an undergraduate student, or for a minimum of five (5) hours as a graduate student.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that SGA make the following amendment to Article V of the Constitution:

Section 1. Students elected or appointed to any position on the SGA are required to have and maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA for all courses completed at the University of Illinois Springfield, except for first-year students with no credit (0 credit hours). Members of the student body who serve on the Student Government Association or represent the student body by appointment of the SGA to campus or university committees must maintain at least half-time status at the time of appointment/election through the duration of their term in office. Half-time status is defined as being enrolled for a minimum of six (6) credit hours as an undergraduate student, or for a minimum of four (4) five (5) hours as a graduate student. Students who are in their final term of study and are completing only courses required for graduation are exempted from the half-time status requirement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this amendment to the SGA Constitution be voted on by the student body during the Spring 2017 election period.
